

## Hope Branch Book Sale

One question that we are often asked here at the library is, "What do you do with your discarded books?" The answer is a simple one; we send them on to our library book sale. In addition to discarded material, we sell donated items. Whenever we get donated books, we go through them to see if we might want to add them to the library's collection. If we do not, then they are sent on to the library book sale as well.

The books, tapes, and videos that we sell at those book sales allow the library to raise money to pay for speakers and provide prizes for our summer and winter reading programs, in addition to other projects. Needless to say, they are a significant source of income for the library. The book sales at Columbus have continued to be popular, and we've decided to hold a book sale here as well. The Hope library hasn't held a booksale for years, so we've decided that we're overdue!

On Friday July 11th and Saturday July 12th, the Hope Library will hold a book sale from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm each day. We will have all types of material; picture books, novels, nonfiction, chapter books, and audio visual material as well. The prices are as follows:

Hardbacks: \$1.00

Paperbacks: 50 cents

DVDs/videos: \$2.00

CDs/cassette tapes: \$1.00
