POLICY FOR CIRCULATING MATERIALS TO HOMEBOUND USERS

- A. A Homebound user is defined as a person who is unable to leave his/her home to visit the library.
- B. A caregiver, volunteer, or BCPL staff member can register a borrower as a Homebound user.
- C. Borrower's cards for Homebound users are kept at the Adult Circulation desk.
- D. The caregiver, volunteer, or BCPL staff member selects and delivers materials to a Homebound user.
 - 1. Lists of materials that have been read by individual Homebound users are maintained by the person who selects and delivers the books and other items.
- E. Homebound users can check out books, magazines, audio books, and compact discs from the adult or juvenile collections.
- F. Homebound users do not receive overdue notices, and they do not pay fines.
