POLICY FOR CHILDREN'S PROGRAM ATTENDANCE AND ADMISSION

- A. Children's programs are designed and advertised for specific age groups.
 - 1. Only children who are the specified age may take part.
 - 2. If a child has been registered using a false age, the Children's Librarian may request that the child be transferred to the correct age group session.

- B. Publicity about a program will specify if parents or guardians must attend with their children.
 - 1. A parent or guardian must remain with the child during the entire session for which parental attendance is required.
 - 2. Parents and guardians cannot attend programs that are specified for children only.

- C. Most storytimes and craft sessions require prior registration.
 - 1. Registration is for the entire run of the program series.
 - 2. "Walk-ins" will be allowed only if a session has not been filled during registration.

- D. Special parties and programs such as Reading Club parties and holiday parties will require a free ticket for admission.
 - 1. Tickets will be distributed in advance of the program or on the program day.
 - 2. Only persons with a ticket will be permitted to attend.
 - 3. Parents or guardians who accompany their children must have tickets.
 - 4. Adults who are not accompanying a child will not be permitted to attend any portion of the event regardless of whether or not a ticket has been issued to this adult.
