

BARTHOLOMEW COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY

POLICY FOR BARTHOLOMEW COUNTY RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Bartholomew County residents and persons who own real property (real estate) in Bartholomew County receive free library service from BCPL.
 - 1. Residency is verified by the mailing of the borrower's card.
 - 2. Non-residents who own Bartholomew County property must provide verification with a current real estate tax receipt.
 - 3. Business owners who do not own real estate are not classified (by Indiana law) as property owners for the purpose of obtaining a borrower's card.
- B. Edinburgh residents, whether living in Bartholomew County or Johnson County, receive free library service from BCPL.
- C. Non-residents or persons who do not own real estate in Bartholomew County or reside in Edinburgh can obtain borrowing privileges:
 - 1. By purchasing a Public Library Access Card (PLAC).
